Castle built in 1280

XVI. Century: **masters** and their crafts
The **stone wall**: 930 m long and 4 m in height- in
200 years those 4 meters reached 15

14 whatchtowers: the Clock Tower, the Tanner's, the Tailor's, the Smith's, the Furrier's, the Bootmaker's, the Butcher's, the Rope-maker's, and the Tin Tower (these still exist). The Barber's, the Fitter's, the Weaver's and the Cooper's Tower don't exist today.

Most visited: the Clock Tower- clock and pharma museum, great panorama on top




You can get lost anywhere with anyone

20. Dracula is whatching.


